

How it works



Let's work together to create a nostalgic 'How We Were' range for your location.

We start by asking you to visit our website to find an image you would like to see on your artwork.

Next you can pick your products. We have lots to choose from; take a look through this brochure.

Now the fun begins! Our designers will source the original glass-plate negative and scan it with highresolution equipment. We'll send a watermarked image over to vou for comments and to make any alterations that you require.

Once this is approved we will send you visuals of your products.

Then our production team will create your products and send them to your door - this normally takes four weeks from approval of the visuals.

Each order is delivered with a point-of-sale package to help you promote the range in your retail space - see page 7

Important bits

To cover the design and set up charges we ask that you place a minimum initial order of £500 +VAT.

The price includes up to two amendments to the artwork at the design and proofing stage.

In the unlikely event that you decide to cancel the order after the artwork has been created a cancellation charge of £125 +VAT will be incurred, this will be offset should the order be reinstated.







Based on the photographic excellence of Fred Judge FRPS, Judges was founded in Hastings in 1902 and quickly established itself as one of the country's leading publishers of postcards, opening branches throughout the UK.

During his lifetime he won over 100 trophies, exhibited in America, Australia, Japan and New Zealand.

He was specially honoured with one man shows in London, New York and Washington and had 83 acceptances in the annual exhibitions of the **Royal Photographic Society**

In 1927 Fred relocated the business from the town centre to its current iconic premises. Over the decades the building was expanded, equipment modernised and today the company upholds Fred's ethos of creativity and quality to cater for modern demands.

How We Were highlights the nostalgia in what has changed and what has stayed the same throughout the years. Relive the beauty of yesterdays world.




